Abigail for great artwork. Harry for great work in science classifying animals.

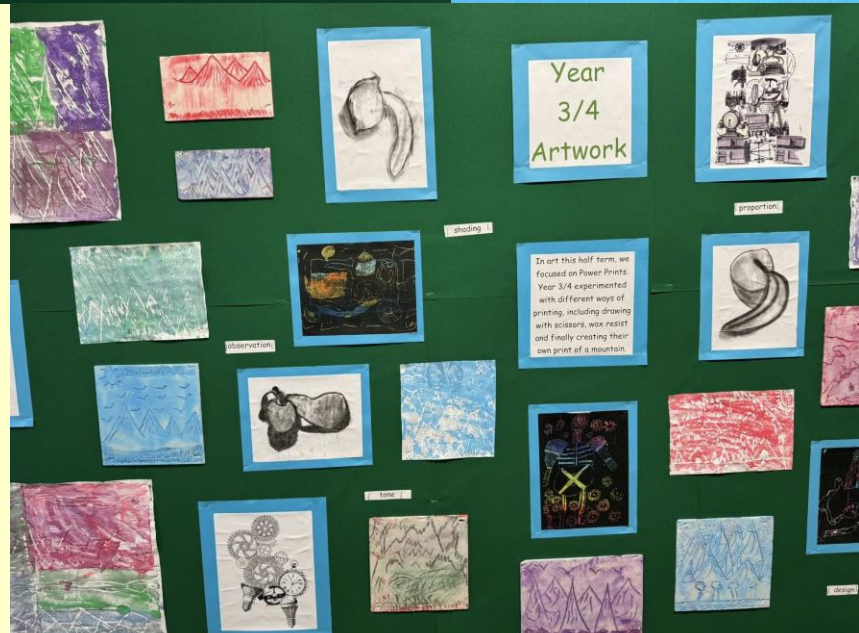
Star Pupil: Dawson for always being ready to learn.
